## Easter Offering Service

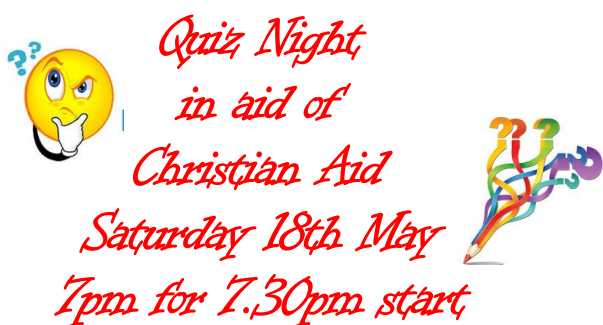
