So using 'Zoom' at **7.30pm Monday 11<sup>th</sup> May** I will begin using a course produced by the Bible Society that aims to give an overview of the Bible. The video content may be a quite basic refresher course but the discussion times should enable us to dig more deeply. Also Journeys and Torrington Group may want to restart soon using Zoom.

Particularly for those of you without experience of using Zoom at **7.30pm this Monday, 4<sup>th</sup> May**, we will have a practice session with a chance to catch up with other church friends.

Zoom is a video conferencing program and if you don't already have Zoom on your computer when you click on the link you will be asked to download a small application to your computer. Once you have done this Zoom will allow you to join the meeting. Once you have downloaded the program (application) you will not need to download Zoom again and it will automatically open next time you join any future Zoom meeting. If asked about audio, please click on 'use computer audio'.
