(Personal Reflection on Monday evenings 7.30 - 8.30pm)


1st Monday evening meeting: 22nd February 7.30 – 8.30pm)

It has been designed so that it can be done as a 6-session course for small groups **or for personal Bible contemplation**. So I hope that everyone will engage with it in some way as it explores the Gospel readings for Lent and brings in some other interesting passages from recent authors.

It isn't an academic Bible Study but instead encourages us to use our imaginations to engage with the Bible passages. I expect the group sessions to last up to one hour.
