As you will know, the above service, led by our own Rev Roger Dunlop, will take place on the above date; what you may not know is that, during this service, we will also celebrate the adult baptism of brother and sister, Andrew and Hayley Knight, who have attended several services at RMMC in recent weeks. We are happy to share with them this occasion at which they will declare their faith. At the moment, social distancing has restricted the number of seats available in the body of the church. Demand for seats, at this particular service, is liable to be high, so early booking is recommended. We would not wish anyone to be disappointed so, thanks to the hard work of the AV team, the service can now be transmitted virtually live (just a few seconds' delay) to the church hall; if you cannot be accommodated in the main church you may be able to attend the service in this 'overflow' facility...or, of course, you may prefer to join the live streamed service in the comfort of your own home; a link will be provided, in the usual way, prior to the service.

The service, at which we say farewell, give thanks and celebrate Roger's time here in the Harrow & Hillingdon Circuit, will be preceded by refreshments, to be served in the Car Park from 5.15pm (again, Covid and, possibly, weather permitting)!

KNITTED SQUARES CHRISTMAS TREE

If you would like a dedication or would like to put some flowers in church one Sunday please add your name to the list. It's always uplifting to have a display of flowers in church for the services, it doesn't have to be a big display just some in a vase would be lovely.

But please be sure to top them up with water if they are there for more than one week and also to dispose of them when they are finished, as a vase of dead flowers is not very welcoming.

Open and looking forward to welcoming you back!

We are delighted that the Discoverers are now back to meeting in the church hall and, although they aren't yet able to join us at the start of the weekly service, it's good to know they're not far away. If you've not yet returned to church in person for Sunday morning worship, you might be interested to hear how we're dealing with arrangements at the moment...

Entry is via the Torrington Road glass doors and you are greeted by one of the Welcome Stewards. You are asked to wear a mask indoors, and a hand sanitising machine is provided just inside the door. Seating has been allocated in advance so you are led to your allocated, numbered seat/s. You are asked not to move around more than essential, once seated. Seating inside the church has been very carefully measured out, to ensure social distancing guidance is followed. A one-way system is in place inside the building - you enter via the concertina doors and exit via the double doors. The toilets are available, also following a one-way system via the coffee lounge doors and returning via the "coats' corridor". At the end of the service, you are shown out of the church via the Ashburton Rd doors, unless you are unable to manage the steps, in which case you may exit via the Torrington Rd doors. The preacher usually stands just outside to say goodbye and we are asked not to congregate (excuse the pun!) at the doorway, to enable others to pass at a safe distance. We are not currently allowed to offer refreshments at the end of

the service, nor to sing hymns but some preachers have encouraged us to hum along with the hymns, which are shown as YouTube clips!

I hope that gives some reassurance, if you are thinking of returning but were unsure what to expect. As always, if you are in a 'vulnerable' group, the advice is not to attend public worship and we want everyone to feel safe. Obviously if you have any symptoms or feel unwell, please stay at home. Due to social distancing, there is less seating available than usual - but so far we've been able to accommodate all those who have wished to join us.
