#### **COVID UPDATE**

As promised, the issue of Covid precautions was raised for discussion at the Church Council meeting on 9<sup>th</sup> September 2021. An easing of precautions had been considered – and, it goes without saying, that everyone would welcome this - but, with Covid numbers still rising, and guidance from the Government and from the Methodist Connexion being to remain careful, it was felt best to continue, for now, with the current strategy which has, so far, kept everyone at RMMC safe and allowed some confidence in attending services; these precautions include: ventilation, sanitising, social distancing and the wearing of face masks.

You are therefore requested to continue these practices but, when seated, you may now remove your mask, if preferred; when standing, however, (to move around indoors or sing hymns) you are politely requested to respect others around you by replacing your mask (unless exempt).

#### **BOOKINGS**

With several services in the next few weeks likely to attract larger-than-average congregations, it was also felt necessary to continue with the booking system. Alana has kindly agreed to take over the bookings' system from this coming Sunday onwards. You are asked to book your seats, in advance, no later than 6pm on the Saturday (occasionally on the Friday – this is always stated in the weekly newsletter)\*. At this time the seat allocation (which doubles as a Track and Trace form) is scanned and forwarded to the Church Steward on duty. So far, except for 'special' services, such as the Farewell Service for Roger, spare seats have been available so, if you accidentally miss the deadline, it might still be possible to fit you in. Obviously if you have any symptoms or feel unwell, please stay at home.

It was agreed that the situation re bookings and Covid precautions would be reviewed once again at the end of October, by the Minister and Stewards' team, in consultation with the Risk Assessment Officer and a decision made, at that time, how to proceed thereafter.

#### Refreshments

I'm sure everyone has been looking forward to a return to regular after-service refreshments — an opportunity to chat informally over a cuppa and a biscuit or two in the Coffee Lounge is a very important part of the social and pastoral life of the church. Unfortunately, the still-increasing Covid numbers make refreshments, as we used to do them, an impractical idea.

<u>However</u>, we wish very much to welcome our new Minister, Dong, and for everyone to have an opportunity to meet him in an informal way; therefore, we will be offering socially distanced refreshments in the church hall, after the service on 26<sup>th</sup> September. Individually wrapped biscuits and tea/coffee will be provided and arrangements will follow the pattern used at Roger's Farewell Lunch... those attending for refreshments will be asked to wait in the church for a few moments, to allow Dong time to greet those not staying. You will then be called row by row, asked to don masks and sanitise your hands on route to the church hall, where you will be asked to collect your cup of tea or coffee and sit at tables of about 6 people. Once seated, you may remove your mask and are asked to remain seated. Dong will visit each table. Exit will be via the main church hall doors. Please make sure you book early for the service\*, to avoid disappointment, and state whether or not you will be staying for refreshments.

Although we'd like to return to offering refreshments every week, this isn't currently practical - however, by way of a compromise, we will be offering refreshments in the church hall after each All Age service (roughly once a month). The first of these services is 10<sup>th</sup> October.
