Covid Precautions Review

Following some discussion, it was agreed at the Church Council meeting on 17 March 2022 to lift most of the Covid precautions.

Masks will be optional. Hand sanitisers will continue to be available. Ventilation in the church will be continued.

In order to provide for those who wish to continue some social distancing <u>and</u> those who don't - the two <u>central</u> seating blocks will be 'open seating' and the seating blocks <u>either side</u> will be reserved for those who still wish to sit socially distanced from others. Stewards will be able to direct you as necessary.

Please respect one another's choices and bear with the Stewards during this transition to (yet another!) new system.

The Church Stewards will, of course, continue to review week-by-week how this is working and make any adjustments necessary.
