

PALM SUNDAY - 24th March 2024

Those who would like to join them, for a slightly shorter walk, will **meet at the roundabout at 10am**. There will be a short introit/introduction, blessing of the Palm Crosses, sharing of the gospel and the procession will then continue, down Torrington Rd, where it is suggested the group will pause at RMMC to bid one another adieu and perhaps share a prayer for our Christian unity, before the St Paul's folk continue back to their church. This is a great opportunity for us to work together and demonstrate our witness to the neighbourhood. As there will be a brief lull before our service starts at 11am, tea/coffee and biscuits will be available in the Coffee Lounge.
