MHA DONATIONS

In the past, we have automatically sent the donations which we have collected for MHA to the main charity, which is based in Derby. The local groups, such as the Northwood Live at Home Scheme, which used to meet on our premises in the past, are not independent charities and were supported by MHA centrally. Times have changed, funds for MHA generally have reduced significantly, the Northwood Live at Home Scheme has combined with the Ealing scheme to become MHA Communities West London, and neither Ealing nor Hillingdon Councils have been able to make grants for the groups in the last three years. I'm told that financial support from MHA Derby has ceased (apart from a loan) and we have been asked by the Northwood Group to consider giving the donations which we make to MHA, direct to them.

MHA has confirmed that this is acceptable and, as there is still only one MHA charity, I believe that it will not affect any Gift Aid claims for these MHA payments. These proposals have only just been explored, so it was too late to add an explanation to the Newsletter. However, a copy of this note will be put on the Notice Board and I will be happy to have a conversation about it, if there are any concerns. The suggestion for this year is that, if anyone has concerns about the change of recipient, they place their MHA envelope on the collection plate marked "MHA Derby" which will be in the vestibule, so that it can be separated from the other plate for MHA donations labelled for "MHA Communities West London" which will be at the back of the church.
