

Defibrillator

If you come into church via the Torrington Rd doors, you've probably noticed our public defibrillator is now installed and registered on 'The Circuit' [ie NOT the Methodist Harrow and Hillingdon Circuit - this is, confusingly for us, the name of the national defibrillator network!] It's also now connected to **London Ambulance Service** and ready to be used in an emergency - by us or any many of the public dialling 999. Although no knowledge of first aid is required to use the defibrillator and the device is very straightforward, talking you through every step, it is recommended by the suppliers that we (at least some of us) watch this short video (link below). Hopefully, none of us will ever need to use it but, if you do, you might wish to note that the voice speaking on the machine is very loud, so don't jump out of your skin when you open it and she speaks - It's clearly designed to be used, if necessary, in a noisy area!
