A Date For Your Diaries at Ruislip

MARY’S MEALS was set up in 2002 and began by feeding 200 children at a school in Malawi. They now provide a nutritious meal for more than 2 million children in schools each day, across 18 of the poorest countries in the world including Ethiopia, Haiti, South Sudan. Many of the countries are experiencing wars, conflict, hunger and poverty which prevent children from getting an education thus denying them a brighter future. Volunteers work with the local communities where they are seeing a rise in enrolment, attendance and attainment. Each meal served at school costs just 10p. It costs just £19.95 to feed a child for a whole school year. **Wednesday Break** have chosen this as our charity for next year’s fundraising.
