Lent and Easter

Ash Wednesday - 5 March - Julie will be leading an Ashing service at Ruislip, commencing 10am. There will be a Reflective Prayer Space at N Harrow from 4-6pm and a Reflective Service and ashing at S Harrow from 7-8pm.

Julie will be running a **Lent Course** for her 4 churches; this will be on Zoom, Thursday afternoons at 2pm, on the following dates 6, 13, 20, 27 March and 3, 10 April, and the plan is for it also to be recorded, so others unable to join 'live' may watch it at their later convenience.

Palm Sunday Procession - 13 April - as we will be attending a Joint Service at Ruislip (11am) if you wish you may, once again, join the procession led by our neighbours at St Pauls, they will be leaving their church at 9.50am and will reach the roundabout by 10am. We will be able to have tea and coffee at RMMC, before heading to Ruislip.

Last year - on an extremely windy but at least dry Sunday! - some joined the procession at St Pauls, others at the Victoria Rd/Torrington Rd roundabout; at the roundabout, the vicar blessed their palm crosses (they have a slightly different practice to us, so ours had already been given out) and said a short prayer, then we all set off, carrying our crosses, singing a hymn, stopping again, opposite RMMC, for another prayer, before we waved farewell to our friends. It is good to show our community a combined act of Christian worship.

Good Friday - the usual joint Ruislip churches' service will be held at St Martins, Ruislip - further details nearer the time. Alternatively, Rev Margaret Dudley will be leading a 10am service at S Harrow.

Easter Sunday - 20 April - Neil Rees of The Bible Society will be leading our worship.
