UKRAINE ITEM DONATIONS

Many thanks to those who have placed donated items in the white tub in the church lobby – these are, no doubt, already making their way to Ukraine. Please continue to donate items as before*...just a note that clean tin cans should be left ‘whole’ ie unsquashed, in order for them to be made into trench candles.

*Knitted items for babies/children, esp 0-6yrs; knitting wool; new babies/children’s items (perhaps from charity shops); clean (empty, unsquashed) tin cans of any size and old candles (these are made into ‘trench candles’ which are used for heating, light and cooking); tinned food (in date) esp peanut butter; first aid and medical aids/items (inc slings, walking sticks etc) and including out of date new packaged items (which can't legally be used here, eg bandages, plasters etc); cleansing wipes, body lotions and creams; cotton wool balls and cleansing pads (these are soaked in wax to make fire lighters); hotel freebies; children's books, pencils and crayons.

· Also, Ibuprofen, paracetamol, cold and flu remedies, and antihistamines but please hand these directly to Eileen, to be locked away.
